

Peregrinations of ATFW-
I was born in the town of Lexington
-in the lower section of the Mass.
town - called the East Village
Date of my Birth. Sept. 20th 1828.
House not standing - has been removed
or taken down - I was moved with
the family to West Cambridge when
about six years old Lived in the Perry
house on what is now Forest Street My
father built a house on the main Road
in 1836 The family lived there until about
1848 when we moved to a house on what
is now Water Street - House now standing. Was
married in that house to Henry Whittemore
on June 19th 1851 I was then 22 years 8 months
of age Went to live in house now standing
number 417 Mass Ave. Lived there for 13 yrs.
Moved to the town of Dedham Mass for one
year Returned to W Cambridge - and took
the Cutter House in 1865 corner of Mass Avenue
and Water Street. My Husband and our
little boy Henry died in that house
H C W died Aug 16th 1891
